The ACC accomplishes its mission by providing tools, resources, and training that support a better understanding of American systems and the development of knowledge and skills that accelerate economic success.

Previously known as Immigrant Credit Education and Financial Counseling Agency, the organization was restructured in 2007 to a dynamic new nonprofit service model that combines the strengths of a chamber of commerce with direct community services.”
